



# Instructions

## Propane Grill

### 2 x 3 Propane Grill

Includes:  
2 grates  
2 drip trays  
Lava rocks

### 2 x 6 Propane Grill

Includes:  
4 grates  
4 drip trays  
Lava rocks

### Options:

40 lb propane tank  
100 lb propane tank

**Note:** it is recommended that you use a long grill lighter to avoid contact with hands. Always use in a well-ventilated area outdoors.

1. Be sure that all valves on the grill are in the OFF position.
2. Removes grates from the grill.
3. Connect propane tank and open valve.
4. Open regulator valves on the grill slightly.
5. Light each pilot bar-Carefully!
6. Replaces grates on the grill.
7. Turn regulator vales on the grill to desired setting.
8. If grill is not working, sometimes the supply tube needs to be readjusted in the burner because it can move during transport.
